MARIA GALANOS HETOS, EDD

Past President and Emeritus Member Dr. Maria Galanos Hetos passed away peacefully on November 24, 2019, at her home in Memphis, TN. Maria celebrated her 100th birthday this past September.

Maria served as President of our Club in 1951 and again in 1976-77. Together with her late husband Founding Member and Past President Nicholas S. Hetos, DDS, she served the Hellenic University Club with distinction in many capacities for sixty years before moving to Memphis to be near her family.

In 2001 Maria established the Nicholas S. Hetos, DDS, Memorial Graduate Scholarship for Dental Studies to honor her late husband. In 2011 she started a second scholarship for graduate studies in Education, the Maria Galanos Hetos Graduate Scholarship. Although she left Philadelphia more than ten years ago, the Club was always close to her heart and she continued to participate by supporting our scholarship fundraising events.

To her daughters Catherine (Harry) Skefos and Stephanie (Rev. Reagan) Cocke and their families we express our heartfelt sympathy. Her funeral took place on November 27 at the Greek Orthodox Church of the Annunciation in Memphis, and her burial was in San Antonio, TX.

The family has requested that donations in her memory be sent to the Hellenic University Club of Philadelphia Scholarship Fund earmarked for the Maria Galanos Hetos Graduate Scholarship.

May her memory be eternal.

The Winter Honors Dinner will directly benefit our Scholarship Program, the largest grant program among all Greek-American organizations in the Philadelphia region. (This year alone we awarded scholarship grants totaling \$55,000 to 18 undergraduate and graduate college/university students.)

The elegant (but not formal) Sunday evening event will begin at 5:00 o'clock and conclude by 8:00 p.m.; you'll be on your way home at a very civil hour! Among many pluses of the evening: An Open Bar for three hours ... abundant and wonderfully-prepared Appetizers and Entree choices ... \$10 parking (for early registrants) directly across the street from the Arts Ballroom ... and an opportunity to meet our Honoree.
